

Uniform Policies

Upper School

7 -12 Grade Young Ladies:

- Polo shirts (gold, navy blue, pink, or hunter green with school logos)
- Skorts or skirts should be knee length or longer
- Shorts must be worn under skirts
- No body piercing except for one pair of studs/posts earrings
- Only natural hair color, shades, and highlights
- White socks
- Solid color leggings/tights weather permitting
- Fully black shoes, closed toes, and heel coverage
- A pair of sneakers can be kept at school to change into for PE
- No painting, writing, or tattoos on body parts
- No headgear of type is allowed on a student during school hours
- No hoodies in the classroom. Navy-blue sweaters encouraged if cold
- Friday dress code
 - o 7/8th Hunter green polos
 - o 9-12th White button up shirt with logo and navy-blue cross tie

7 -12 Grade Young Men

- Polo shirts (gold, navy blue, pink, or hunter green with school logos)
- Shirts must be tucked in
- Navy blue shorts and pants
- Black belts must be worn
- No body piercings allowed
- Hair must be of reasonable length not extending over the collar/ear
- Only natural hair color, shades, and highlights
- White socks
- Solid black shoes, closed toes, and heel coverage
- A pair of sneakers can be kept at school to change into for PE. Any color
- No painting, writing, or tattoos on body parts
- No headgear of type is allowed on a student during school hours
- Navy-blue sweaters encouraged if cold
- Clean shaven



- Friday dress code
 - o 7/8th Hunter green polos
 - o 9-12th White button up shirt with logo, navy blue jacket, and navy-blue tie

Free Dress Day

- No inappropriate language or pictures on any clothing or outer garments
- No cleavage or midriff visible
- No visible underwear
- Skirts/dresses may not have slits higher than the bend of the knee
- Shorts/tights must be worn under all skirts and dresses
- Any item with stylized holes must have a garment underneath fully covering skin
- No see through or form-fitting clothing
